Museum Scholarships – Two (2) \$500 Awards: Graduating seniors planning to attend a 2 year or 4 year college with a demonstrated interest in local Tracy history

Judith Ann Lee Memorial Scholarship – One (1) \$500 Award: Graduating senior planning to attend a 2 year or 4 year college with a demonstrated interest in local Tracy history

Application Deadline: March 31, 2019

a. General Purpose of Scholarships –

To recognize Tracy area graduating high school seniors who have demonstrated an interest or involvement with the history of the Tracy community.

b. Eligibility Requirements

1. Senior on track to graduate at end of current school year
2. Enrolled in public high school located within Tracy Unified High School District Boundaries and lives within TUSD High School District boundaries
3. Plan to attend accredited 2 year or 4 year college as full time student in Fall following graduation
4. Demonstrated interest in Local Tracy History

c. Application Process - Submission Deadline - March 31, 2019

1. Submit complete signed application form plus volunteer statement or paper/essay or project.

d. Award Selection Factors

1. Extent of demonstrated interest in Local Tracy History, including volunteer service
2. Uniqueness and originality of the local history documented in paper/essay or project
3. Quality of research and/or presentation of statement, paper/essay or project

All applicants will be notified in writing of the determinations by the end of the school year. It is the target to announce award recipients before high school awards night ceremonies. Submissions will be placed in the Museum archives and may be reprinted in the Museum Newsletter.

IV. VOLUNTEER STATEMENT, PAPER/ESSAY, OR PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

1. Volunteer Statements should be 1-2 pages, typed, double spaced, and include name, title, date, page numbers and description of volunteer experience (organization, type of service, hours/days volunteered, reflection on historical relevance and experience).
2. Papers/essays should be at least 2 pages (no maximum page limit), typed, double spaced, and include name, title, and date on the first page or title page; identifying footer and page numbers; and Works Cited or References.
3. Submit papers/essays and statements in hard copy to the Tracy Historical Museum **AND** email in WORD format to tracymuseum@sbcglobal.net.
4. If you are submitting a project, please submit with the application, or arrange delivery to the Museum or other method of review as applicable, by the application deadline. Projects should be labeled with name, title, and date and include a narrative explanation of the project and its relevance to Local Tracy History. Projects will be returned after review if requested.
